84. **APOLOGIES**

85. **MINUTES**

86. **TREMENDOUS YORK**

Wendy Taylor of the City of York Council presented information and
documentation upon a project aiming to plant 50,000 trees within the York
area, during the next three planting seasons (2011-2014). Members of the
Council were recommended to support and to complete and return,
individually, the documentation supplied. Two suggested areas for tree
planting were put forward as the proposed development on the `old` Grain
Store site and the Clifton Hospital site.
